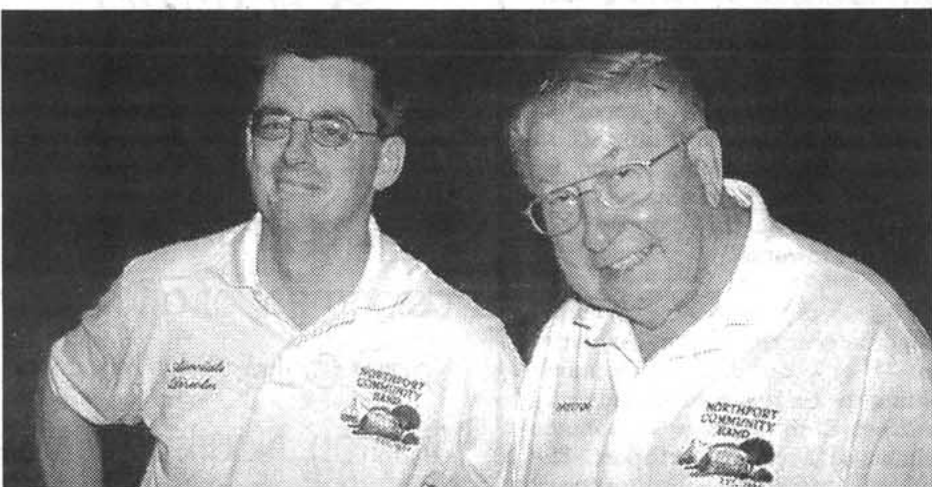


Summertime
